They called it The Runaway Scrape. It was the period immediately after the fall of the Alamo up to the Texan victory at San Jacinto. There was widespread panic as the Mexican Army led by Santa Anna swept eastwards. Fuelled by tales of Mexican atrocities, especially the massacre at Goliad, the settlers picked up, packed up and fled. Since most of the men were away with the Texan armies, it fell to the women to head up the evacuation. Women, children and older people loaded up in wagons, got on horseback but mostly walked as far and as fast as they could. It was cold, wet, and muddy. It was a tough trudge in March and April of 1836. Some made it as far as Nacogdoches. Once word of the victory at San Jacinto on April 21, 1836 spread, the settlers returned to pick up the pieces, start again and build the State of Texas.

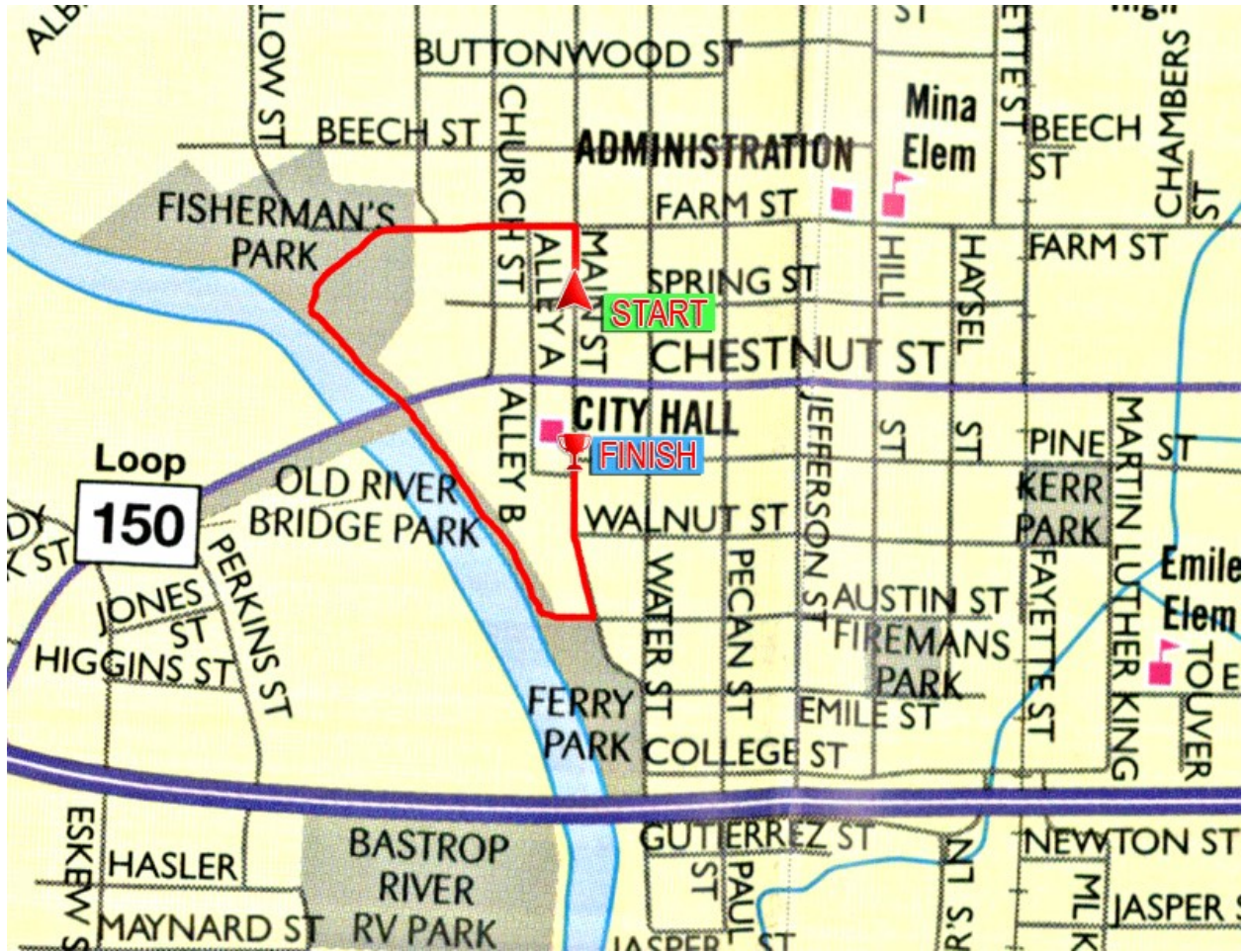
